The debt of the Netherlands, contracted, as all national debts are, to meet the expenses of war, past or prospective, amounts to \$665,000,000. To liquidate this debt would require a tax of three dollars and twelve and a-half cents on every inhabitant of Europe, and seventy-five cents on every individual on the globe. Divided among the population of Holland, the share of each inhabitant would be \$266. The wages of labouring men, throughout the world, probably do not average twenty cents a day. Then, at that rate, three thousand three hundred and forty millions of hard-toiling sons of labour would have to work one day in order to foot this war-bill of little Holland!
