Judges' Salaries.

The Telegraph, after referring to a statement that eighteen new judges are to be appointed in the Dominion, says:—

This provision for the better administration of justice, will, it is to be hoped, be appreciated by a grateful people. We fall to understand, however, why Quebec judges should receive higher pay than the judges of New Brunswick and Nova Scotia, who, as justice, take the front rank in their profession.

This question of "pay" may yet lead to unpleasant complications. If we are to credit the report that the Chief Justice of New Brunswick will throw up the position unless an increase of salary is provided for.

There appears to be no good reason for discriminating against the Lower Province Judges in this matter of salaries. Their duties are full as onerous and their responsibilities as great as those of their brethren of the Bench of Quebec and Ontario. Their time is fully occupied with severe mental labor, and nothing more can be said of the Judges of the other Provinces. It is supposed that a Judge can live more economically in St. John or Halifax than in Quebec or Toronto, the men of the Upper Provinces had better try the experiment for a twelve month. They would be fully undeceived in half the time.

New Brunswick and Nova Scotia pay as much into the Dominion Treasury per head as Ontario and something more than Quebec, and we should receive ten times as much for our public services as that which is paid for similar services in those sections. Yet in other respects than the Judges' salaries, the Lower Provinces come off second best. On the formation of the Union the Government Departments at Ottawa were filled with the officials of Old Canada, and although, occasionally, since that date some petty office is given to a New Brunswick or Nova Scotian, the salaries and position awarded them are so contemptible that the New Brunswickers, it is said, contemplate resigning in a body.

The St. John Banks in Parliament. The Bills for the incorporation of the new Bank for St. John passed the Commons prior to the 27th ult., and has been sent to the Senate. The Journal of the Senate of that date contains the following:—

A Message was brought from the House of Commons by their Clerk, with a Bill intituled: "An Act to incorporate the Bank of Saint John," to which they desire the concurrence of this House.

The said Bill was read for the first time. On motion of the Honorable Mr. Mitchell, seconded by the Honorable Mr. Atkins, it was

Ordered, That the said Bill be read a second time to-morrow.

This is the Bank that is founded by Messrs. Palmer, Simons Jones Nicholson, Thomas R. Jones and others.

Later in the same day the Bill for the Maritime Bank resumed the Senate. The Journal says:—

A Message was brought from the House of Commons by their Clerk, with a Bill intituled: "An Act to incorporate the Maritime Bank of the Dominion of Canada," to which they desire the concurrence of this House.

The said Bill was read for the first time. On motion of the Honorable Mr. Hamilton (Kingston), seconded by the Honorable Mr. Mitchell, it was

Ordered, That the said Bill be read a second time to-morrow.

The Latest Report. The Fredericton "Head Quarters," which appears to have received special information on the School difficulty, remarks:—

"It is supposed that the difficulty has been solved without any violation of the Constitution, and that the terms are that the Dominion Parliament will renew the grant annually received by the Roman Catholic Schools from the Local Government."

The Dominion Parliament under the Union Act, is debarred from dealing with the question of Education in the several Provinces. The support of Schools is absolutely confined to the Local Legislatures; and we judge that to appropriate Dominion monies to the support of Separate Schools in any Province is an undertaking beyond the powers of Parliament, to say nothing of the insult that would be offered to the Province specially interested.

Were such a proposition mooted at Ottawa, our representative would at once denounce and oppose it. Not one of them representing a Free School constituency could afford even to be silent. Public sentiment is now thoroughly alive to the danger that has threatened and will make itself felt in a manner not to be misanderstood.

The Head Quarters will probably have no objection to give its authority for the remarkable statement.

A Young Southerner's Suicide.

DESTITUTE AND DISCOURAGED IN NEW YORK—THE SUFFERINGS OF A CLERK.

On Monday James W. Bushnell was found dead in his room at 135 Hudson street. Doctor Marsh had a post mortem examination yesterday, and ascertained that death was caused by Paris Green. Mr. Bushnell was a native of Winchester, Va., where his father and two children now reside.

Some months ago he was employed in the Boston office of the American Express Co., and obtained employment in the basement auction house of J. W. Campbell & Co., 348 Hudson street. This position he gave up about a month ago, after which time he was out of employment. Becoming despondent, he committed suicide. He was a member of Madison Lodge, No. 6, of Odd Fellows, Winchester, Va.

The following letters were found in Mr. Bushnell's room among his papers. One was addressed to his father, J. W. Bushnell, and the other to his children, Ella and J. E. Bushnell:

OFFICE OF J. W. C. & Co., } 348 Hudson street, New York. } DEAR KIND OLD FATHER: Please and for God's sake forgive me. I remember when we parted you said, "I thought I should never see you again." I thought differently, although I suppose you will be correct. Oh! but how I wish you were here! I cannot see your dear old face once more on earth, but I hope to meet you in heaven. You know what troubles I have had. I have not long had any more upon earth. I will seek one in heaven, which I hope to obtain and where I hope to meet you.

The Sessions says:—There died on Wednesday afternoon, in the Edinburgh Royal Infirmary, the well known Edinburgh character, Alexander Merrick. He was known by the sobriquet of "Sally Kelly." Of the 82 years of his life, he spent a singular portion, more than 40 years in prison, and for the past half century has been considered a pest by the police authorities, having been convicted at the police court about 250 times.

He was born in Edinburgh, and from his native town, Musselburgh, and commenced a career of dissipation, which he pursued until he was 24 years of age, when he was sent to prison for a week. He never learned any trade, but occasionally did odd jobs for any one who would employ him. He was sent to prison for the first time for a year in High street, Canongate, and after frequent thralldoms, to groups of his friends, who were frequently in the habit of visiting him, and who encouraged the flow of his jocularities. It was a very profitable business, and he was the sobriquet by which he was generally known. His appearance at the police court, with very few exceptions, was a result of drink. It was, however, mentioned that he was at one time charged with murder, but after a short stay in prison for some time was released.

Another occasion he was convicted of robbing the case of a public-house. He had been used to slip daily into the shop, and had for some time been in the habit of carrying some money for the purpose of purchasing a beverage, hard ale. When not in prison, he still kept his name in the master-room at the police office, and when for misconduct he was ejected, was taken out of the public-house, and placed in the cells of the building. One of the last offences he committed was that of stealing some tools belonging to a workman who had been making some repairs in a house in the case of the jail for the past half-century, and was thoroughly acquainted with every part of both old and new prison. When sent to the Poor-house or House of Refuge he would not remain, as he used to say the treatment he received in the prison was far superior. In his older moments, while in jail, he was considered a very sensible person, and was of great use in cases of sickness, as he manifested unflinching fidelity in attending to the prison patients.—Bootsman.

Extraordinary Rifle Shooting.

It will be remembered that at the Wimbledon contests in 1870 the celebrated marksman Mr. Edward Rose, and Lieutenant Colonel Fenton (Roedale) one of the best shots in England, tried for the National Association Cup. They were not able to decide the tie at the time, and therefore arranged to shoot a match of 100 rounds to settle the matter; 50 shots at 300, and 50 at 600 yards. This came off at Westwood Hall, the seat of Sir Henry Hallford, in Leicestershire, whether the competitors were invited, and where the shooting has been honorably made in the presence of a number of known rifle shots.
