To Remove Spots from Silk or Cloth.

It is said that grease or oily spots can be re-
moved from silks or cloth by pouring a few drops
of spirits of turpentine on the soiled spot; then
place a sheet of brown paper over the soiled spot
and cover with magnesia, and then cover the mag-
nesia with paper and apply an iron sufficiently hot
to raise the oil or grease from the article. The
grease by this process melts, and the magnesia ab-
sorbs it, and should the stains not be effectually
removed, repeat the operation.
