FRASER, *Hon.* CHRISTOPHER FINLAY, *Q.C.* (*Brockville.*)

S. of Mr. J. S. Fraser, of Brockville, Ont. B. there 1839. M., Miss Lafayette of the same town. Called to the Bar, U.C., Trinity Term, 1865. Apptd. a *Q.C.*, 1876. Is a Bencher of the Law Soc., Ont. Is Presdt. of the Catholic Literary Asso. of Brockville. Was one of the originators of the Ontario Catholic League. Is a director of the Ontario Bank. Appointed a mem. of the Ex. Council 25 Nov., 1873, and was Provl. Secy. and Registrar from that date until 4 April, 1874, when appointed Commr. of Public Works. An unsuccessful candidate for Brockville at g.e. 1867, and for South Grenville, at g.e. 1871. First returned to Leg. Assem. for South Grenville, March, 1872, on death of sitting mem. but unseated on petition. Again returned on new election. Oct., 1872, and by acclamation on his appt. to office; re-elected at g.e. 1875. Was elected for Brockville at g.e. 1879, 1883, 1886 and 1890. A Liberal.—*Public Works Depart., Toronto; Brockville, Ont.*

GARROW, JAMES THOMPSON, *Q.C.* (*West Huron.*)

Is of Scotch descent. B. at Chippawa, Co. Welland, Ont., 11 March, 1843. Ed. in Common Schools of Waterloo Co. and Huron Co., and Goderich High School. M. at Goderich, 17 July, 1872, Mary, dau. of the late Rev. Chas. Fletcher. Called to the Bar, Ont., 1868, and apptd. *Q.C.* by Ont. Govt. Was Reeve of Goderich for seven years, and Warden for one year of Co. Huron. First returned to Leg. Assem. at last g.e. A Liberal.—*Goderich, Ont.*

GIBSON, *Lieut.-Col. Hon.* JOHN MORISON, *Q. C.*  
(*Hamilton.*)

S. of the late William Gibson of Toronto Tp., farmer, who came to this country in 1827 from Glamis, Forfarshire, Scot., and who married Mary Sinclair whose family belonged to the Tp. of Nelson in the Co. of Halton. Cousin of the late David Gibson, who formerly represented North York in the old Parlt. of Can., and who was prominently associated with the late W. Lyon Mackenzie in the troubles of 1837. B. 1 Jan., 1842, in the Tp. of Toronto, in the Co. of York. Ed. at Central Sch., Hamilton, and at Univ. Coll., Toronto. Took the
