That no Person shall have or receive any Part of the same, who was a Dinoz, and under the Age of Sirteen pears, at the Time when the Regiment, Troop, or Comvany, in which he ferved, was reduced; that no Perfon thall have or receive any Part of the same, except such Werson who did adual Service in some Regiment. Croop. of Company; that no Person having any other Place of Employment of Profit, Civil or Willtarp, under his Wajeffy, thail have of receive any Part of the faid Half-pay; that no Chaplain of any Garrison or Regiment, who has any Ecclesissical Benefice in Great Britain of Ireland, shall have or receive any Part of the said Balf-pap; that no Person shall have or receive any Part of the same, who has resigned his Commission, and has had no Commission fince: that no Part of the same shall be allowed to any Person by virtue of any Marrant or Appointment, except to such Persons as would have been otherwise intitled to the same as reduced Officers; and that no Part of the same thall be allowed to any of the Officers of the Five Regiments of Dragoons, and Eight Regiments of Foot, lately disbanded in Ireland, except to such as were lately taken off the Elablishment of Balf-pap in Great Britain.
