

granted to such offender for the offence of which he may have been guilty, or as if he had been specially named, and his offence specified and freely pardoned in and by this Act.

Effect against private prosecutors.

IV. And be it enacted, That this Act shall have as full effect against any private prosecutor or party as against the Queen's Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors.

How this Act may be pleaded.

V. And be it enacted, That any person or party hereby pardoned and discharged, may in any prosecution, suit or action against him or her, founded on any offence from which he or she is hereby pardoned and discharged, plead the general issue, and give this Act and the special matter in evidence.

This Act not to affect certain other Acts.

VI. And be it enacted, That this Act shall not extend or be construed to extend to alter or in any wise affect the provisions of a certain Act of the Parliament of this Province, passed in the Session held in the eighth year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, *An Act to vest in John Montgomery and Thomas Ewart the property forfeited to the Crown by the Attainder of the said John Montgomery*, nor to alter or in any wise affect the provisions of a certain other Act of the Parliament of this Province, passed in the Session held in the ninth year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, *An Act to reverse the Attainder of Peter Mathews and to avoid the forfeiture of his estates and property*, nor to alter or in any wise affect the provisions of a certain other Act of the Parliament of this Province, passed in the Session held in the tenth year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled, *An Act to restore the rights of certain persons attainted of High Treason.*
