An Act to incorporate "L'Institut Canadien Français de la Cité d'Ottawa."

WHEREAS, Pierre Marié, J. B. Turgeon, A. T. W. Reaume, L. A. Preamble.

Lapierre, of the City of Ottawa, and others, have petitioned for an Act to incorporate the Society named "L'Institute Canadien Francias de la Cité d'Ottawa," under the aforesaid name and title; Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the consnet and approbation of the Legislative Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:
