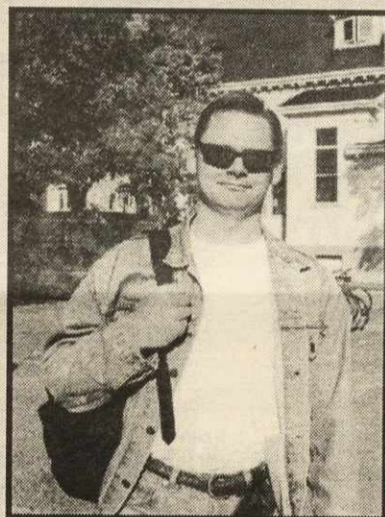
"How they sign people up for classes...there are not enough seats."

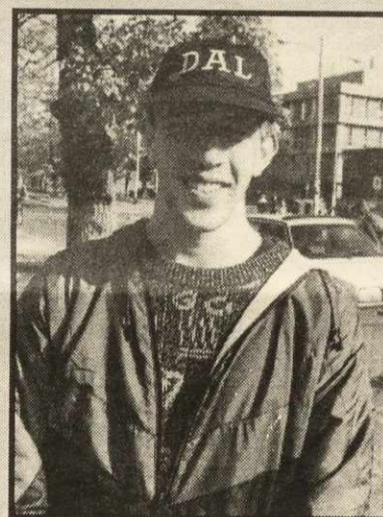

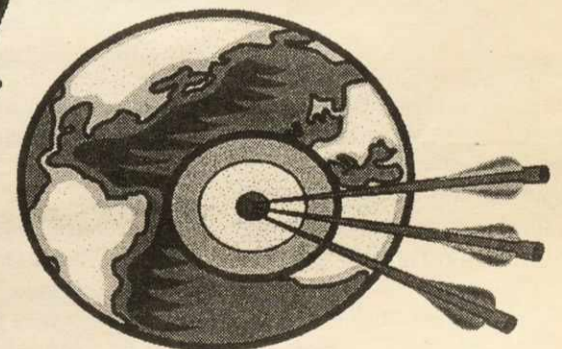

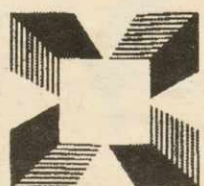
