Dear Sir:-

Would you kindly inform me on the following:

Two years ago, I built a house on a lot which I thought to be the property of the Government. Today, the Indians want me to move. I am very poor and I have 13 children. I dug my cellar for the storing of my harvest of potatoes, next fall. The Indians would like me to move this fall but I have not the means to do it. Would you kindly issue a permit allowing me to move next spring only, when I might get some help.

My house is built only 7 feet on the Reserve.
