The Co-ordinating Committee on International Broadcasting that the broadcasting of propaganda to Europe could be done most effectively from the territory closest to the Continent. The Priorities Office of this Department was advised by the War Production Board on May 13th, that an AAS priority had been assigned to the Canadian application for 2 transmitters and equipment. This rating is not sufficiently hight to ensure early delivery.
