Sir:-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 13th instant dealing with lands in Crooked Lakes Reserve, and in reply to say that it will be necessary for you to furnish an Assignment as well as an Assignment fee of one dollar before the land you refer to can be entered in your name, as the sales were entered here in accordance with the names furnished by Mr. Kenning who was acting for you, to the clerk of the sale.

Regarding Mr. Kennings land, I have to say that on the ~~13th~~ 31st March last, a statement was furnished him showing what lands were entered in his name; being 11 quarter sections, and his reply of the 3rd ultimo is to the effect that he was in error as to what lands he owned and that the Department was quite correct.
