Ottawa, May 20, 1911.

Most Reverend Sir,

I have the honour to acknowledge the receipt of Your Grace's communication of the 9th instant nominating Mrs. Magrath, wife of the Missionary at Grisevald, as teacher of the Oak River school.

In reply I beg to say that the Department has received an application direct from Mrs. Magrath and, while not fully assured as to her qualifications for the position, is disposed to give her trial at this school. A teacher who could have devoted her whole time to the school work would have been preferable; however, as Mrs. Magrath has had some experience in Indian work she will be notified of her temporary appointment at an initial salary of \$300.00 per annum.
