I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 21st instant, in regard to lease to your company covering ranching privileges on the Kamloops Indian reserve, and have to inclose copy of lease, duly executed by the Department. In regard to the question of occupation of the reserve, I may say that under the terms of the lease you obtain grazing rights on this reserve as therein provided and no cattle except yours and the Indians' will be allowed on the reserve.
