Memorandum for file:

Prime Minister telephoned to Washington today to thank Mr. Stone for message; also to tell him of present intentions which are to stay until Saturday morning at Virginia Beach and then go on to Williamsburg. Stay at Williamsburg Inn probably for a fortnight.

Mr. King also suggested Tuesday, April 22nd, as possible date for visit to Washington. Said would probably spend the night of April 22nd-23rd at Blair House. Mr. King also mentioned possibility of Thursday, 17th of April, as possible date should he not stay on longer at Williamsburg.
