Sir Hector Langevin's Seat Won by the Liberals.

A Tory Majority of Over Three Hundred Wiped Out.

SOREL, Que., Jan. 12.—A. Brunau (Reformer) has been elected to the Commons for Richelieu. Majority, about 100. At the recent general election Mr. Langevin (Con.) carried the constituency by 308 majority.

The Inter-State Commerce Commission. Ex-Congressman William R. Morrison, whom President Harrison has just reappointed to his place on the commission, was born in Monroe county, Illinois, Sept. 14, 1825; is a lawyer by profession, was clerk of the Circuit Court; was four terms a member and one term a Speaker of the Illinois House of Representatives; was elected to the 38th, 43rd, 44th, 45th, 46th, 47th and 48th Congresses, and was re-elected to the 49th Congress as a Democrat. In 1886 he was defeated for re-election to the 50th Congress by John Baker, of Belleville, Ill., the Republican candidate. Subsequently the ex-Congressman was appointed Inter-State Commissioner by President Cleveland.

Disastrous Railway Runoff

A Train Pitches Down a Fifty-Foot Embankment.

Scarcely a Passenger on Board Escapes Injury.

Two Persons Killed Outright and a Large Number Seriously Hurt.

CRAWFORDSVILLE, Ind., Jan. 12.—Yesterday afternoon the north-bound Monon train ran off the track about two miles north of here, at Nicholson Crossing. The accident occurred on a 50-foot embankment, down which four cars rolled, the engine and one baggage car keeping the track. The first passenger coach rolled over three times, and the rest of the train followed. The train was crowded with passengers, but all the occupants escaped alive. The baggage and express car went over, but no one in it was seriously hurt. The ladies' coach was literally torn to pieces, as was also the parlor car. There was hardly a passenger on the train who escaped injury. Help was soon at hand, and in a few moments the roadway was full of the maimed on the way to the town. They were theatrical troupes on board, one of which was the City Club Burlesque Company, which was completely wrecked, nearly every member sustaining serious injuries.

The killed are: Ben. Hamburg, Cincinnati, a traveling man; Madame Eina Van Rokey, of the City Club Company.

The injured of the City Club Company are: Mack Rogers, badly hurt in the legs and back; Gus Rogers, back injured; Stella Clifton, legs and back injured; Helen Love, internally injured; Cora White, Syracuse, N. Y., slightly injured about the head; Fanny Everett, St. Louis, internally injured; Olla Lewis, bruised about the head; Harry C. Bryant, Philadelphia, back sprained and head hurt; Madge Larner, Pittsburgh, Pa., head bruised; M. Rutledge, potter, chin hurt; George C. W. Loefer, St. Louis, head hurt; John Dill, conductor, leg badly injured; Nellie Hanley, crushed, will die; Erna Hibbs, left arm broken and right hand cut off; Mrs. Ann Hibbs, face smashed; Dr. E. White, sides and spine seriously fractured; Dave Maltry, Rome, eye gouged out; John Dill, conductor, leg badly injured; Greenleaf, Ind., right leg cut off below the knee; Fox, New Albany, head cut and leg smashed; Paul Allen, head crushed; Thos. Monson, of the opera troupe, hurt internally; C. F. Hoyt, side and back and head injured; C. W. Loefer, St. Louis, leg badly crushed; Mr. Marshall, Elliottville, side and face crushed; J. J. Enright, Chicago, knee and head hurt; Melvin McKee, Chicago, head, hip and back injured, but not fatal.

MANY OF THE INJURED WILL DIE. A number of those hurt live here in the city, and several will probably die. It was one of the most terrible catastrophes that has ever occurred on the road. The postal car went over, but the clerks, Fox and Clark, who badly cut, are not badly hurt. The rescue was made by the local fire department, and a little girl supposed to be buried in the debris.

NEW TYPE OF BAYONET AND CARTRIDGE. ROME, Jan. 12.—The new repeating rifle adopted by Italy will be provided with a new type of bayonet, much shorter than the one now in use. A lieutenant of artillery is now searching for the best powder adapted to the new rifle. The powder adopted will develop progressively the effects of the gas arising from its combustion, increasing to an extraordinary degree the initial velocity of the bullet. It is also reported that the weight of the cartridges will be reduced, and that the muzzle velocity will be increased to allow them to carry in the field 150 rounds of the small carbine cartridge.
