## ADVISES BRITISH MATERIAL ONLY

Times Would Have No Foreign Products at Exhibition

DIFFICULTIES ADMITTED

Suggests Co-operation and Good-Will Will Overcome Obstacles

LONDON, Oct. 30.—(Canadian Press Cable).—The Times, in a leading editorial on the question of British products being exclusively used at the British Empire exhibition, which is to be held in 1924 at Wembley Park, says the object lesson of a self-supporting empire is desirable enough to justify a special effort to secure its achievement. The existence of difficulties in matter of confining the products at the exhibition to those of the empire cannot be disputed. The Times says, but suggests that with co-operation and good-will on the part of all concerned most, if not all, of the difficulties, can be overcome.

The dominions, colonies and protectorates, The Times adds, will now have it in their own hands to make good any imperfection which may exist in the machinery for obtaining the supplies.

## FIND DEATH DUE TO ALCOHOLIC POISONING

KITCHENER, Oct. 30.—The jury inquiring into the death of Frederick Hanreuk, a Ukrainian who died suddenly on October 1 after being in a stupor, to-night found that the deceased came to his death through alcoholic poisoning.

There was no evidence to show where and how the deceased secured the liquor, and the analyst's report was that there was no poison discovered in the stomach.

However, Dr. P. Melnosh expressed the opinion that alcoholic poisoning caused the death, and pointed out that it was quite possible that this would not show in the analysis.

**SIR GEORGE RHODES WEDS.**  
LONDON, Oct. 30.—Mrs. Diana Morgan Hill, widow of H. Morgan Hill, of Washington, was married to Sir George Rhodes at noon to-day in St. Mary's Roman Catholic Church. Sir George and his bride, after a honeymoon in Scotland, will make their home in London. Sir George Rhodes, who is 60 years old, is the father-in-law of Ian MacPherson, who was minister of pensions in the Lloyd George Cabinet.

## PLANS TO RAISE CAR MEN'S WAGES

Mayor of Detroit Would Also Give Them Annual Vacation

SYSTEM IS OWNED BY CITY

People to Vote on Barring the D.U.R. Cars From Streets

DETROIT, Oct. 30.—Platform men on the Detroit municipally-owned street railway lines are to receive either a wage increase or shorter hours, if the plan announced to-day by Mayor Couzens, acting head of the Detroit Street Railway Company, is carried out. In addition the platform men will receive an annual vacation with pay under the plan. The new plan will be tried out on one line of the city for the next month and if found practical will be extended to the other lines, the mayor announced.

Operators of one-man street cars will receive a wage increase of five cents an hour, while other workers are to be given the eight-hour day at their present wages. The present working day is nine hours.

A proposal that the Detroit United Railway be denied use of the city streets for its interurban cars will be voted on November 7, the City Council to-day bringing down a resolution that the proposal be taken off the ballot. If the proposal is adopted interurban

passengers will be required to transfer to city cars at the city limits.

## RESUME PARLEY THIS WEEK ON PROPOSED MERGER OF UNIONS

Italy's Political Change Will Hamper Mr. Fielding's Plans.

OTTAWA, Oct. 30.—Italy's dramatic change of government will probably delay conclusion of a proposed trade arrangement with Canada. When Hon. W. S. Fielding, finance minister, went to Europe it was understood, although not officially announced, that, following conclusion of a new trade treaty with France, an endeavor would be made to improve Canadian trade relations with Italy.

## ANGORA GOVERNMENT ACCEPTS.

CONSTANTINOPLE, Oct. 30.—Hamid Bey, the Nationalist representative in Constantinople late to-night received a note from the Angora Government for presentation to all allied high commissioners, accepting the invitation of the allies to the peace conference at Lausanne.
