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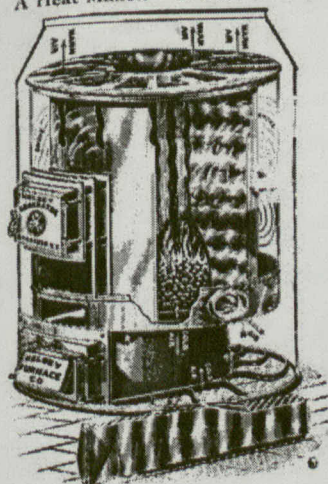
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St. Mary's Sch., July 9th, 1904.
