Graph 6 illustrates the levels of revenues forecast for 1993-94. Given the projected volume of 1.37 million passports to be issued in 1993-94, the estimated level of revenues rises to \$48.3 million. This increase is due primarily to increased volume. The total expenditures forecast for 1993-94 are illustrated in *Graph 7*. We estimate that in 1993-94 the expenditures will reach \$48.3 million.

This increase is due largely to increased volume and other corporate initiatives to be undertaken in 1993-94.
