1876 Inquiry by the Honorable Mr. Dever:—

February 14—Whether any immediate action will be taken by the Government in carrying to completion that portion of Railway, at *St. John, N. B.*, known as the *Courtney Bay* Railway extension, which is now in a most unpleasant state of apparent abandonment, notwithstanding the large amount of public money expended thereon, and the great desire manifested by merchants and others for a deep-water terminus at that Port?

By the Honorable Mr. *Kaulbach*:—

- “ 15—That an humble Address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General, praying that His Excellency will cause to be laid before this House, copies of all papers and correspondence between the Government and the “Direct Cable Company” the “Anglo American Company” and all other Atlantic Companies since the 1st October, 1873.

By the Honorable Mr. *Bureau*:—

- “ 16.—That a Select Committee be appointed to inquire into the working of “The Insolvent Act of 1875,” and to report what amendments thereof, if any appear to be advisable, with power to send for persons, papers, and records.

By the Honorable Mr. *Botsford*:—

- “ 16.—That an humble Address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General, praying that His Excellency would be pleased to cause to be laid before this House, a detailed statement shewing the total amounts expended on the grounds and fences in front of the Parliamentary Buildings from the first day of January, 1870, to the first day of January, 1876, with the estimated cost of completing the same; also, a detailed statement shewing the total expenditure on the new Library, distinguishing between the expense of the outward construction and the cost of completing the interior, during the same period; also, a detailed statement shewing the total expenditure on the addition to the Western Departmental Building, with an estimate of the amount required to complete the same.
