

The lower house dining room can be used for ladies' dinners, provided the party is not less than ten, but the room cannot be engaged before 6 p.m. of the day previous to which the dinner is to be given, and this only when not used as the strangers' room.

Both the house and strangers dining rooms can be used for card playing on the following conditions: If required for dinner or supper, the room must be vacated one hour and a half before required for either meal. A charge of \$2.50 will be exacted for an afternoon or an evening, unless a private and special luncheon or dinner of eight is ordered in one of these rooms, in which case no extra charge will be made for the room should the same party remain to play cards afterwards.

DRESSING ROOM.

Portmanteaus, bags or baggage of any kind must be taken away immediately after use, and not allowed to remain in the Club House for future use.

No servant of the Club is to be employed by any member to clean clothes, or to assist him in dressing.

No servant of a member is allowed to go into any other room than the dressing room, and then only to assist his master in dressing.
