

CARADOC GIRL WINS PRIZE ESSAY AT MIDDLESEX FAIR

"Farm Organizations" Is Subject of Essay by Winnifred Wallace, Who Captured County Prize.

The following essay, which shows an extraordinary grasp of the situation which confronts the farmers today and events leading up to it, was written by a public school girl of Caradoc, Miss Winnifred Wallace, and awarded the first prize for the county, at the Mount Bridge School Fair.

"In Unity There Is Strength." Almost all the trades, labor and professions have realized this and have

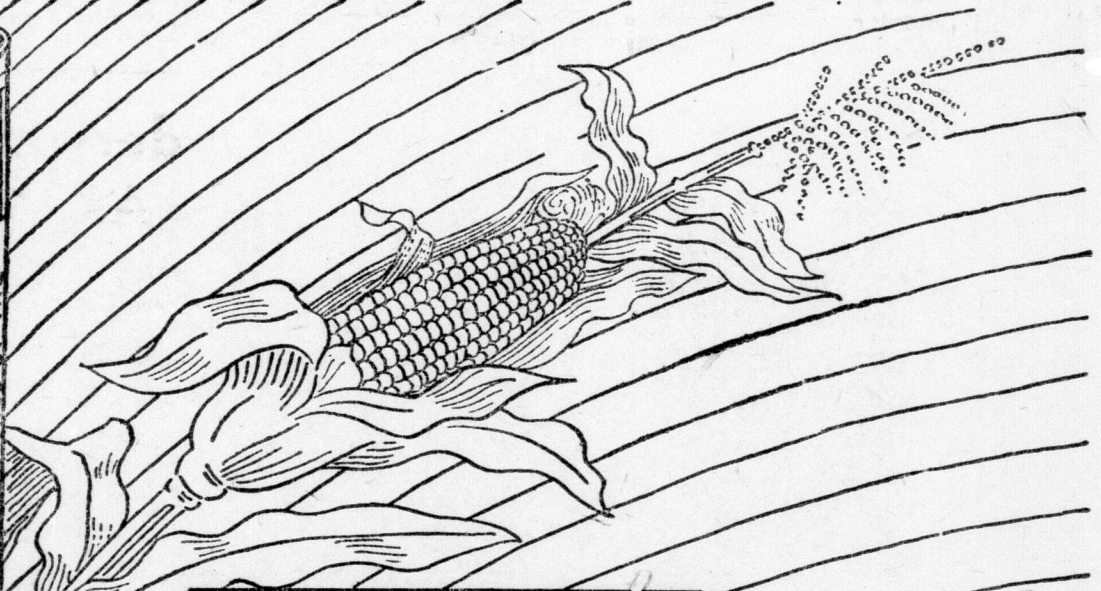
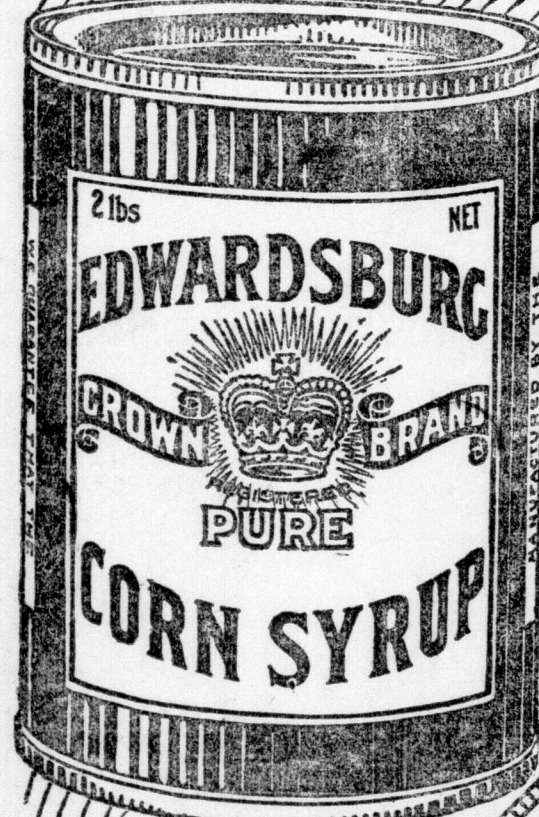
