REDUCTION IN PRICES OF VARIOUS COTTON GOODS IS FEATURE

Due To Declines in Raw Cotton
Markets—Some
Metals Easier.

Hardware and Metal says:

"The outstanding feature of hardware markets this week has been the reduction in prices of various cotton goods handled by the trade.

WOMAN POLICE OFFICER FOR BRANTFORD PROPOSED BY COUNCIL OF WOMEN

Police Commission Favorable, But Can
Not Make Appointment This
Year

Brantford, Oct. 2.—At a meeting of the board of police commissioners held on Thursday, Mrs. Livingston and Mrs. Brewster, representing the Local Council of Women, presented their case, asking for the appointment of a woman police constable in Brantford. The commissioners commented favorably on the case, and promised to have an appropriation in the estimates for 1921. No action could be taken, however, this year, the police appropriation not being sufficient.

At the organization of the mothers' pension board for this city yesterday, Judge Hardy was elected chairman, Mrs. Wright vice-chairman, and Corney Simmonds secretary. Some 40 applications for pensions have already been received, but the board took no action, pending the appointment of two additional members by the government.

The trades and labor council has called on the city council to regulate the supply of anthracite coal for the winter, also to cut down the supply of gas and electricity for industrial use for the protection of domestic consumers. The labor men are also after a change in the policy of granting a fixed assessment to industrial concerns.
