Returns Show Drop of Million Tons as Compared with Preceding Quarter.

Total ship construction throughout the world during the quarter ended December 31, 1921, showed a decline of more than a million tons gross as compared with the preceding quarter, according to a statement issued by Lloyd's Register of Shipping. Of this, the British decrease represents about 640,000 tons, the American about 215,000 tons, and that of the other countries complined about of the other countries combined about 225,000 tons. The total for the United States, however, is now only half what it was three months ago, while the British decline is only about a fifth, and that of other countries only about a tenth from the total of the preceding


