Ottawa, July 20—Canada's total trace for the twelve months ending April 80, 1918, as published in a bulletin by the department of trade and commerce, was department of trade and commerce, was \$1,079,984,018, a splendid increase compared with the corresponding period last year, when the total was \$879,611,888. The total imports were \$678,587,617; exports were \$401,846,401. The amount of duty collected was \$115,641,977.

One of the most interesting items in the list of imports is settlers effects brought in by immigrants. During the twelve months ended April 30, this year, the value of these from the United States was \$10,296,265 as compared with \$4,900,274 from Great Britain.
