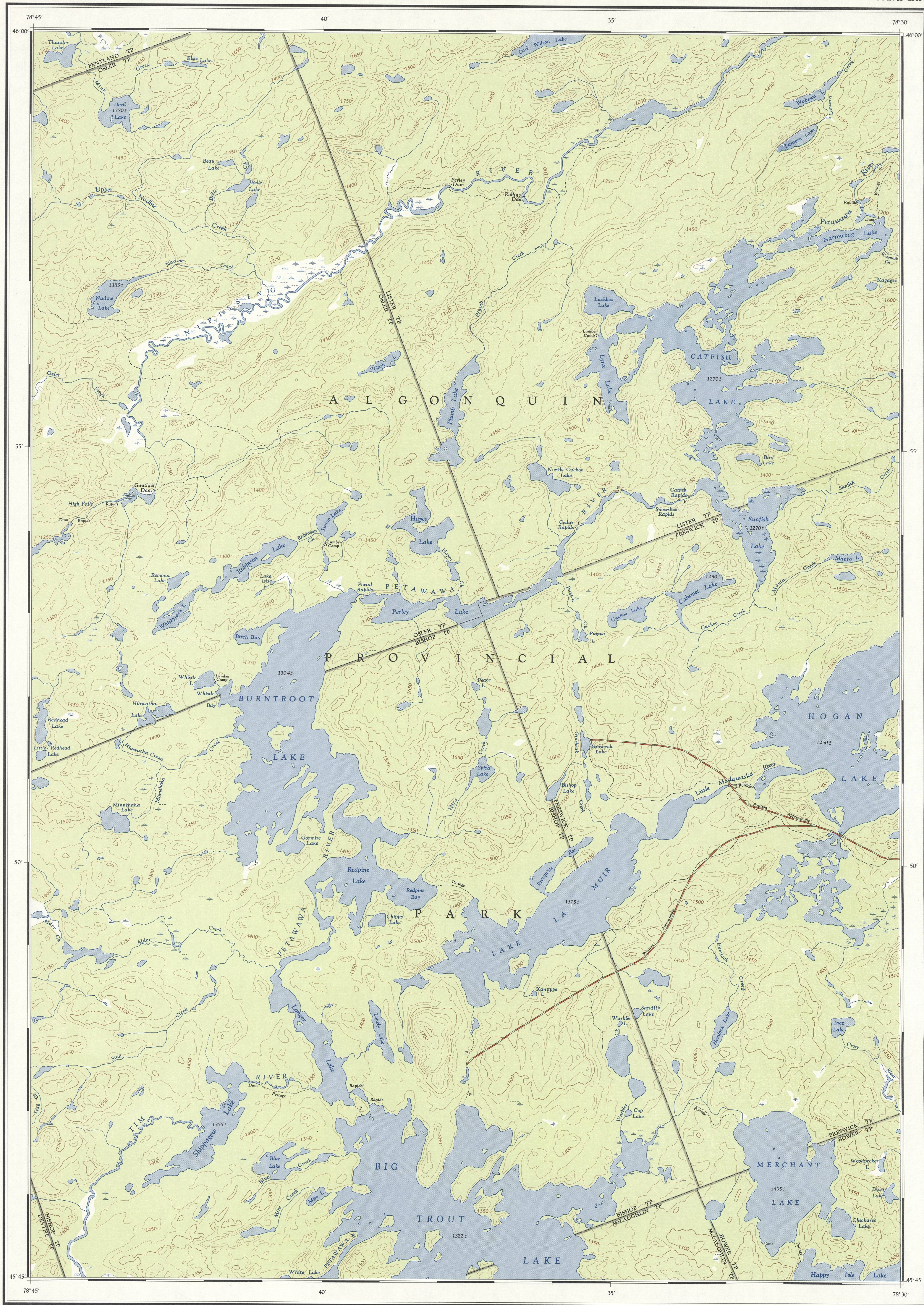

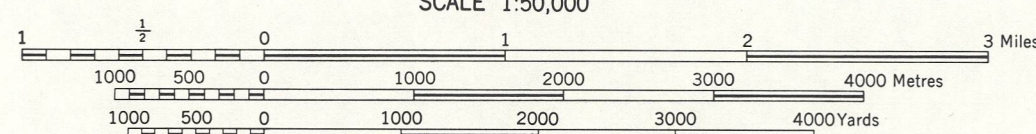
BURNTROOT LAKE
