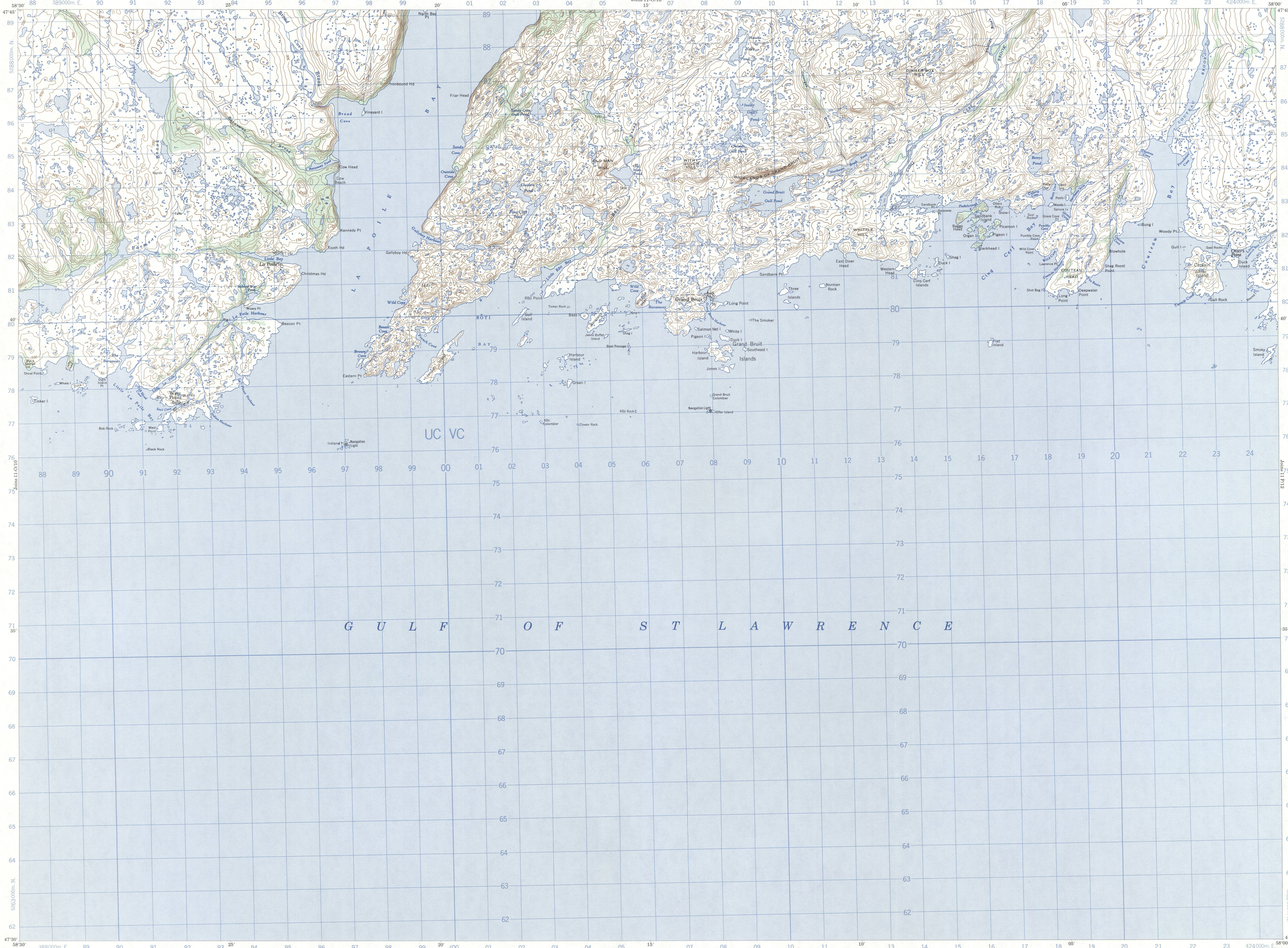

EXAMPLE OF METHOD USED
TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES
THE FOLLOWING GRID REFERENCE IS A SIMPLE ONE
AND DOES NOT REFER TO A POINT ON THIS MAP

REFERENCE POINT CHURCH (as above)

EASTING: Read number on grid line
immediately to left of point
Estimate tenths of a square from
this line eastward to point

NORTHING: Read number on grid line
immediately below point
Estimate tenths of a square from
this line northward to point

EXAMPLE MILITARY GRID REFERENCE: 975084
Nearest similar grid reference 100,000 metres (about 63 miles)
