

ENTREPRENEURIAL PLANS

Over \$200,000,000 in the Estimates

Foster, Aghast at Raid on the Treasury, Protests

His Appeal Not Likely to Be Heeded as the Tory Motto Seems to Be "A Short Life and a Merry One."

Ottawa, March 24.—The cabinet council spent yesterday getting the final draft of the supplementary estimates for the coming fiscal year ready for presentation to the commonsense either tomorrow night or early on Tuesday.

The pruning knife, wielded principally by Hon. Geo. E. Foster, was freely used, but the aggregate still left enormous. The estimates for public works alone, as submitted by the minister, totalled about \$18,000,000 and ministerial supporters from all parts of the dominion have been stubbornly insistent in getting liberal amounts for their respective constituencies.

It is expected that the total of the supplementaries will be in the neighborhood of \$20,000,000, bringing the total expenditure voted by parliament this session, including railway subsidies, aggregating \$81,000,000, will pass the \$200,000,000 mark.

Large votes for the Welland canal enlargement, for the Hudson Bay railway, and for the militia and agricultural departments will be included. The minister of public works has already promised for a large sum in the supplementaries to enable a beginning to be made this year on the Georgian Bay canal, but it is probable that project will be delayed for a little while longer pending further surveys and reports from experts as to the commercial feasibility of the route.

In view of the extent of the supplementaries and the large amount of business still before the commonsense and the senate, it is probable that the estimates will be reached until Wednesday or Thursday of next week.

SELLS FARM IN BRITISH COLUMBIA; MAY SETTLE HERE

Englishman Greatly Interested in New Brunswick and May Succeed in Getting Several Friends at Home to Come Here to Live.

Friday, Mar. 22.—Having made a success of farming in a British Columbia and sold his holdings there at a good profit, S. Brentnall, an Englishman who was in the city yesterday, said that he will not return to the West, but if he returns to Canada he will try his luck in New Brunswick. Mr. Brentnall arrived in the city for the purpose of taking passage on the C. P. R. steamer Empress of Ireland which is to steam tomorrow for Liverpool, but hearing of the great opportunities for taking up vacant land in New Brunswick, he made some inquiries yesterday, and last evening he discussed the prospects of securing a considerable quantity of land, with some prominent members of the board of trade.

He said yesterday that he had been in London with some friends in England who were thinking of coming to Canada to take up farming, and that if he were satisfied with the openings in New Brunswick he might be able to persuade them to enter on an enterprise in this province.

SUSSEX SCHOOL BOARD BACKED UP

AN UNRULY BOY

Principals Who Disciplined Lad Had His Order Reversed, But Authorities Soon Found Out Their Mistake and Expelled Offender.

Sussex, N. B., March 21.—The news of the school trouble at Chatham follows closely on the heels of a similar episode in Sussex. Recently a pupil of grade VIII was denied the privilege of eating dinner in the second floor of the school building as a result of his having, it is said, flooded the upper hall by means of the fire hose, but he stoutly denied having done it.

Becoming weary of his separation from his school mates, he applied to the school board to be restored to the privileges enjoyed by the other pupils. The board consented, and summoning the principal, Mr. Helges, the pupil and his mother, ruled that the boy was being unjustly treated, and ordered his reinstatement.

Jubilant over his success, the boy soon defied even the board itself in promoting a school drive, which the board had expressly forbidden, and later being caught in passing improper notes to one of his girl companions, was summarily expelled by the board.

The matter leaking out has caused much comment in the town, as the failure of the board to support the principal has seriously affected the discipline in the whole school. The dismissed pupil, who has spent four years in doing grades VII and VIII, left this week to attend the academy at Sackville.

OPPOSITION TO NEW BRUNSWICK HYDRO-ELECTRIC BILL

Charlotte County Interests Object to Giving Company Expropriation Powers—Matter Stands Over.

Fredericton, N. B., March 22.—The corporations committee held their first meeting this morning, Mr. Slipp presiding, and took up the New Brunswick Hydro Electric Bill. Messrs. P. W. Thomson and W. E. Foster, two of the promoters of the bill, appeared with H. A. Powell, K. C., N. R. Cockburn, K. C., and R. B. Hanson as counsel. J. W. C. C. appeared for the New Brunswick Union of Municipalities, F. R. Taylor for Senator, C. G. Gilmer for Senator, and also with A. C. Gilmer on behalf of Senator Gilmer and the Gilmer estate.

Considerable progress was made with the bill. Regarding a section providing that before the company could enter St. John with its lines, etc., it should comply with the regulations of that city regarding the use of streets, it was suggested that St. John was safeguarded in that respect under another section of the bill.

J. E. Wilson, M. P. F., objected to having the section taken out of the bill and said that while he did not wish to place any unnecessary handicap in the way of the project he nevertheless felt that the city of St. John was in a different position than the parishes on account of the many uses to which its streets had to be put and he urged that the section remain in the bill.

Mr. McCready suggested that the bill be amended so that it would provide that the company should comply with the regulations of any city or town before entering upon the use of its streets and that this would protect St. John as well as other places. The section was adopted with the proposed amendment.

F. Howard Grimmer opposed the section of the bill giving the company expropriation powers and urged that, with the development now taking place in the province, it was not well that valuable powers should be handed over to corporations such as this bill would create. He also urged the government to follow up the expropriation powers which the bill would give the company.

The committee adjourned until next Tuesday morning with a suggestion from the chairman that in the meantime the representatives of the Gilmer estate and the company should get together and try to arrange upon terms whereby the company might take over the Gilmer interests.

A meeting of the agriculture committee, under the chairmanship of Mr. Galt, gave an address on agriculture in New Brunswick. A resolution was passed recommending that the government send a delegation to various localities to demonstrate these practices in seed selection, soil cultivation and care of the crops and the results that can be obtained by good practice.
