

Sir Arthur Currie.

Dean Adams:

"I think that you should write to the Secretary of the Royal Society asking him to bring this matter before the President of the Society with the request that he would, on behalf of the Society, bring it to the attention of the Government at the earliest possible date, so that a proper sum may be inserted in the supplementary estimates for the present session.

I will, as Acting Chairman of the Council for Scientific & Industrial Research, write to the Government asking them to make this grant.

Seeing that all the universities in the Dominion are especially interested in this matter I think you should get the Presidents of the Universities to make further representations.

It will be advisable to act as quickly as possible in this matter seeing that the main estimates are going through now and it is believed that the session will terminate in June."

Dr. A. S. Eve:

"I recommend that you approach Dean Adams and Dr. Ruttan, who are each of them on the Committee or Board of the Honorary Advisory Council of Industrial and Scientific Research. It is clear that this is a Canadian rather than a McGill affair, and that it should have the support of the whole Dominion, including other Universities. I think that they would bring the matter before Mr. Ross, who is Chairman of the above named Board."

Dr. A. B. Macallum:
