

enjoy all the benefits of the School Act, 9, Vict. c. 27. year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to repeal certain enactments therein mentioned, and to make better provision for Elementary Education in Lower Canada,*" shall in so far as they may be applicable, 5 and such extension may be practicable, extend to the Municipality to be organized under the provisions of this Act, and the inhabitant householders therein, having under this Act the right of voting for any Municipal Councillor, shall accordingly be individually and collectively affected and bound by, and shall enjoy all the advantages of the Act last aforesaid, and may vote under the same at all elections of School Commissioners or other School Officers, under the same, 10 as if they were therein specially mentioned and referred to; anything in the said Act to the contrary notwithstanding. 15

The said inhabitants to have all the benefits of the Small Cause Act, 7 Vict. c. 19. III. And be it enacted, That all and every 20 the provisions of the Act passed in the seventh year of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, "*An Act to provide for the Summary Trial of Small Causes in Lower Canada,*" shall in so far as they may be applicable, and such extension may be practicable, 25 extend to the Second Municipality of the said County, by virtue of this Act, upon the Petition of at least one hundred resident inhabitants being householders; such Petition 30 being certified as required in and by the first section of the said Act, and all the other requirements of the said Act with regard to the appointment of a Commissioner or Commissioners for the Summary Trial of 35 Small Causes, being also complied with and observed.

The said inhabitants exempted from property qualification as Justices of the Peace: under 6 Vic. c. 3. IV. And be it enacted, That each and 40 every person being a resident householder in the new settlements aforesaid on the banks of the River Saguenay or any of its tributary streams, or between Tadousac and Point des 45 Monts, who now is or hereafter shall be appointed a Justice of the Peace in and for the new settlements aforesaid, shall be and is 45
