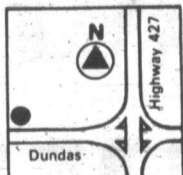

## Credit Valley plan 'a nice gesture'

### McMillan

Streetsville Mayor Hazel McCallion's policy plan to purchase 500 acres of the Credit Valley for recreational purposes is a "nice gesture" but it must be followed up with money — at least \$2 million — says Credit Valley Conservation Authority (CVCA) chairman Roy McMillan.

"But anyone can make a gesture" he pointed out.

Mrs. McCallion has said the town will attempt to purchase the land between the proposed Hwy. 403 and Hwy. 401, therefore taking in a part of Mississauga contained in a Streetsville annexation bid.

McMillan says the cheapest possible price for valley lands is \$3,800 an acre. Most landowners also consider flood plain land as valuable as table land, he added.

He pointed out that some time ago Markborough Properties, the developers of Meadowvale, offered Streetsville valley lands on the river below the development but the town refused.

The CVCA chairman also noted that three farms, all of about 200 acres each, had been sold in that area recently. He said their individual prices were in the millions of dollars.

 his police cruiser he was "being assaulted" by the accused who was pulling on his arm to try and free one of the arrested persons.

Jones said he was already having considerable difficulty with the two prisoners, who had been drinking, when Thompson began pushing and tugging at him.

There were about 30 persons in the Villa parking

lot at the time of the arrests. During the melee, a police cruiser was driven from one end of the parking lot to the other.

Thompson, according to Constable Jones, leaned against the police cruiser as the officer approached with the prisoners, preventing him from putting them in the car.

The accused, who conducted his own defence, said he was making a telephone call in the Villa when the ruckus began. He said a friend asked him to go

outside and get his wife. Thompson indicated he found another friend in handcuffs when he went outside.

A bartender at the time, the defendant said he was not guilty because of "a case of mistaken identity." He admitted being in the parking lot but said Constable Jones "asked me to beat it and I did."

Prompted by Judge August to explain why the officer would lie about the events, Thompson made no reply.

"After hearing all the testimony," the judge told Thompson, "it becomes a question of your evidence against the evidence of the police constable. Under the circumstances, I accept the evidence of the officer in any conflict."

Judge August said that if Thompson had been standing idly by as he said, it would not have been necessary for Jones to make the warnings to the accused.

Thompson was given two months to pay the \$300.
