Statement of Rules and Regulations drawn up by the Cumberland Chief and Council for the benefit of Cumber-land Band of Indians.

1.

All Indian children of this band being in health, from the age of six years to fifteen years, shall attend the day school, unless they receive permission from the Teacher to be absent. The parent or guardian of any child who fails to so attend shall be liable to a fine of five cents for each day of the absence of such child from School.

2.

The Chief in Council shall have power by written or printed notice to be posted up on the door of the School House, to call out all the male members of the band of the full age of twenty-one years to perform statute labour for the benefit of the band and on the Reserve. Any such member of the band who fails to perform such labour in obedience to such notice, shall be liable to a fine of one dollar for each day of such failure, unless he shall have received the written permission of the Chief to be absent.

The owners or occupants of houses and tents on the reserve shall keep the same clean, and shall not allow refuse matter to accumulate in the vicinity thereof, and
