

No. 133 - The 1945 payroll shows 1 man only on this number while this payroll shows one decrease "Death" - "Woman died, date unknown". If the 1945 payroll was correct should the 1946 notation now read "Man died, date unknown"?

No. 183 - The 1945 payroll shows 1 man, 1 woman, 1 boy and 1 girl while this payroll shows 1 man, 1 woman, 1 boy and 1 girl with one decrease "Other Causes" - "Girl transferred to new ticket No. 226". Assuming that the 1945 payroll is correct there should be only three people shown this year. If so, there has been an overpayment of \$5.00 made to this family. If an overpayment of \$5.00 was made please make a notation in the office copy of the payroll and collect this \$5.00 when paying Treaty next year. The "Number on Previous Payroll" would appear to be 4 not 3 also please advise why girl was transferred to No. 226.

No. 185 - The 1945 copy of the payroll shows 1 girl while this payroll shows 1 woman. Assuming that the girl has become of age it is correct to show her under the same number as a woman only if there never before was a woman shown under this number.

No. 199 - The 1945 copy of the payroll shows 1 man, 1 woman, 1 boy and 1 girl while this payroll shows 1 man, 1 woman, 1 boy but no decrease. Please advise what because of the girl shown under this number last year, the "Number on Previous Payroll" having been 4 not 3.

No. 210 - The woman shown on this ticket last year has apparently not yet been corrected and should not be shown as a "Decrease". The \$5.00 due her should be shown as "Amount Due Absentees". Please make the necessary entry in the office copy of the payroll.

No. 215 - The 1945 copy of the payroll shows 1 woman while the 1946 payroll shows 1 man; please advise.

No. 216 - Please note that there is \$10.00 arrears paid this family for the year 1945. Our copy of the payroll shows this family as having been paid in full for 1945. It would appear, therefore, that an overpayment of \$10.00 has been made to this family, if so, please make a notation in the payroll and collect this \$10.00 when paying Treaty in 1947. The "Number on Previous Payroll" for this band would appear to be 466 not 467 and apparently the number of "Deaths" is 21 not 22.
