

No. 133 - The 1945 paylist shows 1 man only on this number while this paylist shows one deceased "Death" - "Woman died, date unknown". If the 1945 paylist was correct should the 1946 notation now read "Man died, date unknown"?

No. 183 - The 1945 paylist shows 1 man, 1 woman, 1 boy and 1 girl while this paylist shows 1 man, 1 woman, 1 boy and 1 girl with one deceased "Other Deceased" - "Girl transferred to new ticket No. 226". Assuming that the 1945 paylist is correct there should be only three people shown this year. If so, there has been an overpayment of \$5.00 due to this family. If an overpayment of \$5.00 was made please make a notation in the office copy of the paylist and collect this \$5.00 when paying Treaty next year. The "Number on Previous Paylist" would appear to be 4 not 3 also please advise why girl was transferred to No. 226.

No. 185 - The 1945 copy of the paylist shows 1 girl while this paylist shows 1 woman. Assuming that the girl has become of age it is correct to show her under the same number as a woman only if there never before was a woman shown under this number.

No. 199 - The 1945 copy of the paylist shows 1 man, 1 woman, 1 boy and 1 girl while this paylist shows 1 man, 1 woman, 1 boy but no deceased. Please advise what became of the girl shown under this number last year, the Number on Previous Paylist having been 4 not 3.

No. 210 - The woman shown on this ticket last year has apparently not yet been married and should not be shown as a "Deceased". The \$5.00 due her should be shown as "Femme Due Absentee". Please make the necessary entry in the office copy of the paylist.

No. 215 - The 1945 copy of the paylist shows 1 woman while the 1946 paylist shows 1 man; please advise.

No. 316 - Please note that there is \$10.00 arrears paid this family for the year 1945. Our copy of the paylist shows this family as having been paid in full for 1945. It would appear, therefore, that an overpayment of \$10.00 has been made to this family, if so, please make notation in the paylist and collect this \$10.00 when paying Treaty in 1947. The "Number on Previous Paylist" for this band would appear to be 486 not 487 and apparently the number of "Death" is 21 not 22.
