
Ottawa, Aug. 10, 1915.

Sir,-

In reply to your letter of the 28th ultimo, I beg to say that the Department is glad to learn that Mrs. Obottossaway of the Sucker Creek Band will be received as a patient in the Sault St. Marie General Hospital. It is observed that there will be a fee charged for operation, but that it will not exceed \$50.00. It is assumed that such charge will cover all expenses in the matter other than the per diem charge of \$1.00 made by the Hospital.

The accounts for maintenance and operations should be rendered in detail and in duplicate and should reach the Department through Mr. W. McLeod, Indian Agent at Manitowaning.
