Referring to official telegram of 6th September, 1929, in connection with sub-lease to District of Surrey, by Campbell River Mills, Limited of half an acre of land in Semiahmoo Indian Reserve, I have to request that you will be good enough to report fully in this matter, so that the necessary adjustment may be made.

Rental for the first year has been received by the Department, but, seemingly, should be returned to James Charles, locatee of land held by the Campbell River Hills, Limited, he being locatee of the only land held by these lessess.

As this matter is urgent, a very early report will be greatly appreciated.
