- Q.19 Now, under those conditions which you have described, if the accused wished to proceed to the Town of St. Stephen would he require special authority?
- A.19 Oh! yes, it was outside the duty area.
- Q.20 And what officers would be authorized to give him that authority?
- A.20 I should say any of the Headquarters Staff, plus, the Transport Officer.
- Q.21 Who was the Transport Officer at the commencement of the Camp?
- A.21 At the commencement of the Camp it was Lieutenant Curran of the R.C.A.E.C.
- Q.22 How long did he hold the position of Transport Officer?
- A.22 Approximately the 26th of July - I mean approximately the 26th of June until the 10th of July.
- Q.23 Do you recall what day of the week the 10th fell on?
- A.23 No - the days are all alike there except Sunday.
- Q.24 The 10th?
- A.24 I am not certain what day that would be?
- Q.25 Now - what regulations governed the use of vehicles at the Camp at that time?
- A.25 The vehicles were generally for the use of the Camp - as I stated before - ordinarily to get a vehicle from the Park it was necessary to make requisition for it, by 1600 hours the day before unless the vehicle was specially detailed to a certain party or a certain unit.
- Q.26 Before a driver is granted a Driver's Certificate what requisites are necessary - I mean to say, what instructions must he receive?
