KWHAWINSUCH BAND

Mag-wek-stala, Burley Bay: Recommended that ten (10) acres be granted on the eastern shore of a small bay lying to the northeast of Pulp Lease 487, on Mackenzie Sound.

d7

Hikums, Watson Island: Recommended that if possible ten (10) acres be set aside on Hopetown Passage, taking in the small bay and the Indian village site on the south shore of Watson Island, so as to work no detriment to the holders of the pulp concession.

d11

Kunsiamis, Claydon Bay: Recommended that one hundred (100) acres be granted out of the fractional piece of land lying to the east of T. L. No. 21442.

d12

Klekka, Drury Inlet: Recommended that Gleyka I.R. No. 6 be enlarged by the addition thereto of twenty (20) acres immediately to the North.

d14

Sinku, Rocky Bay: Recommended that ten (10) acres be granted at the mouth of a river on T.L. No. 24386, where the Indian houses are.

Kadis, Dixon Island: Recommended that this be granted, approximately eighty (80) acres.

KWICKSITANEAU BAND

e1

Hardar, Bond Sound, now recognized as I.R. No. 3 of the Village Island Band: (NOTE -- On the blueprint there is marked "I.R." a tract of land lying to the south of I.R. No. 3, which tract does not however now appear as a Reserve in the Official Schedule nor on the Departmental survey plots). Recommended that this tract be regularly constituted an Indian Reserve of the Kwicksitaneau Band. Indian Reserve No. 3 is given in the Schedule as belonging to the Village Island Band, whereas it has always been claimed, occupied, used and locally recognized as belonging to the Kwicksitaneau Band. (NOTE -See Minutes of Decision).

e4

Gwasi: Recommended that this application be granted, the land given fronting from T.L. No. 15682 to the head of the Bay and twenty (20) chains deep, from the northern boundary of T.L. No. 15682, the old mill-site.

e5

Meetup or Mitap, Village Island Reserve No. 2: Recommended that this Reserve be confirmed to the Kwicksitaneaus instead of the Village Island Band, but without enlargement.

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
