Indian Reserve No. 3 is given in the Schedule as belonging to the Village Island Band, whereas it has always been claimed, occupied, used and locally recognized as belonging to the Kwicksitaneau Band. Gwazi: Recommended that this application be granted, the land given fronting from T.L. No. 15682 to the head of the Bay and twenty (20) chains deep, from the northern boundary of T.L. No. 15682, the old millsite.

Meetup or Mitap, Village Island Reserve No. 2: Recommended that this Reserve be confirmed to the Kwicksitaneaus instead of the Village Island Band, but without enlargement.
