Especially to be mentioned is the third section, "Sharing God's Word," which is an excellent dialogue for Junior girls representing Christian and heathen girls, and the Exercise on William Carey for boys, and Heroes of the Mission Fields, for boys, or this could be used in a variety of ways. This pageant is truly a Mission Band Treasury of material.

**NEW** "USE AGAIN LETTERS." Don't you wish you could print charts and posters that would be so useful for your Circle, Band or Church generally? Well, you can, by means of these letters as patterns. They make letters 1½ inches high, you can have them outlined, blocked, printed in black ink or colors. Write about them. (50c. postpaid).

**NEW** Band Jubilee Book, "GLIMPSES AND GLEAMS." Oh, but that's OLD, you say. It must be new to some people, and Bands who have not seen it; yet, and anyone who has not had it, have missed something—the best ever Band story book. (25c.)
