### HOMESTEAD REGULATIONS

A NY even numbered section of Dominion Lands in Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta, ex-cepting 8 and 28, not reserved, may be homesteaded by any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, to the extent of one-quarter section of 190 acres, more or less.

There must be made personally at the local land office for the dis-trict in which the landis situate. Entry by proxy may, however, be made on certain conditions by the frither, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of an intending homestender.

The homesteador is required to perform the homestead conditions under one of the following plans: (1) At least six months' resi-dence unon and cultivation of the land in each year for three years.

(3)-If the father (or mother, if the father is deceased) of the homestender resides upon a farm in the vicinity of the land entered for, the requirements as to resi-dence may be satisfied by such person residing with the father or mother.

(3) If the settler has his per-manent residence upon farming lend owned by him in the vicin-ity of his homestend, the require-ments as to residence may be sat-isfied by residence upon the said bread. land
