Corporation may hold cer-

2. The Corporation, hereby created, may acquire, hold, may now certain real estate in the City of Montreal, as may be required for actual occupation by the corporation for the purposes of this Act; and the same may, from time to time, morigage, or sell and dispose of, and replace by other real estate for the said purposes.

Capital stock.

3. The capital stock of the Corporation shall be twenty thousand dollars, divided into shares of fifty dollars each, which shares shall be transferable; and its affairs shall be managed by five Directors, who shall be Stockholders, and who shall be First Directors, elected as shall be provided by the By-laws; and until Directors shall be so elected the persons hereinbefore named shall be the Directors of the Corporation.

By-laws for certain purposes.

4. The Corporation may make By-laws, not contrary to law, for the election of the Directors thereof, the subscription and calling in of shares, and the mode of and restrictions upon the transfer or forfeiture of such shares; the good government, maintenance and regulation of their real estate and other property, for the preservation of order and regularity in the practice of the exercises hereinbefore mentioned, the declaration of dividends, and for the management of the affairs of the Corporation generally, and may amend and repeal such By-laws from time to time, and generally shall have all needful powers for the purposes of this Act.

Returns to the Legislature.

5. The Corporation shall, at all times, when thereunto required by the Governor, or by either branch of the Legislature, make a full return of its property, real and personal, and of its receipts and expenditure for such period, and with such details and other information as the Governor or either branch of the Legislature may require.

Public Act.

6. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.

An Act to incorporate the Victoria Skating Club of Montreal.

[Assented to 9th June, 1862.]

Preamble.

HEREAS James Torrance, John Greenshields, John Lewis, George M. Miller, Alfred Brown, John J. Jones, Thomas Morland and others, have petitioned for the incorporation of themselves and others, as the Victoria Skating Club of Montreal, and to that end have represented that they have need to be enabled to hold such real estate as may be requisite for the formation of a Skating Rink in the City of Montreal, and the erection thereon of suitable buildings over and about the same, and are desirous of being incorporated for such purposes, under the name of the Victoria Skating Club of Montreal;
