



PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of this Island stands Prorogued until THURSDAY the *Twentieth* day of *November* instant : And whereas, I think fit further to Prorogue the said General Assembly until THURSDAY the *Twenty-ninth* day of *January* next ensuing :

I do, therefore, by this my Proclamation, further Prorogue the said GENERAL ASSEMBLY until THURSDAY the *Twenty-ninth* day of *January* next ; *then to meet for the despatch of business.* And of which all persons concerned are required and commanded to take due notice and govern themselves accordingly.

teenth Year of Her Majesty's Reign.
