Thinks War Will Mean Vast Changes and Bigger Armies.

Bristol, Eng., Sept. 8. - The British Trade Union Congress now meeting here, adopted at to-day's session a resolution expressing belief in the complete justification of the position of Great Britain and her allies in the war. The resolution read: "This trade union congress, whilst expressing opposition to all systems of militarism as a danger to human progress, considers the present action of Great Britain and her allies as completely justified, and expresses its horror at the atrocities, which have been committed by the German and Austrian military authorities, and the callous, brutal and unnecessary sacrifice of lives of non-combatants, including women and children, and hereby pledges itself to assist the government as far as possible in the prosecution of the war."
