

"It will behoom us," it says, "to bring all our forces to bear and leave no stone unturned secure the defeat of any candidate wh seeks your suffrage, who is not prepared to give us the fullest guarante that he will do all in his power to cure the enforcement of conscription and aid to the fullest extent the suc cessful prosecution of the war. It must be also our earnest endeavor to imbu our fellow-citizens with the knowledge which we ourselves possess d the true state of affairs at the battlefront, and so impel them to act as we know they would did they realize how

serious the menace is that confronts The manifesto in closing, remine the members of the association this their body is an independent one and determined to remain so. That fact however, it asserts, does not remove from the association the obvious dut of supporting the principles for which its members have fought, and opposing those candidates who would permit Canada's further participation in the war to cease.
