Ten persons were instantly killed and many terribly injured.

It was found necessary to turn a stream of water on the crowd from a fire engine standing near before the dead and wounded could be taken out.

People rushed from the outside up the narrow stairs and were crushed by the crowd forcing its way to the streets.
