And Whereas by an Act passed in the Session holden in the Twenty-ninth and Thirtieth Years of Our Reign, intituled "An Act for the Union of the Colony of Vancouver Island with the Colony of British Columbia," it was enacted that the Colony of British Columbia should after the said Union comprise all such Territories within the Dominions of Her Majesty as are bounded to the South by the Territories of the United States of America, to the West by the Pacific Ocean and the Frontier of the Russian Territories in North America (now belonging to the United States of America), to the North by the Sixtieth Parallel of North Latitude, and to the East from the boundary of the United States, northwards by the Rocky Mountains and the One hundred and twentieth meridian of West Longitude, and should include Queen Charlotte's Island and all other Islands adjacent to the said Territories, and Vancouver Island and the Islands adjacent thereto: And Whereas such Union has been duly effected under the Provisions of the said Act:

Boundaries.

Now know you that We have Revoked and Determined, and do by these Presents Revoke and Determine the said recited Letters-Patent and every Clause, Article, and Thing therein contained, except so far as the same repeal certain Instructions addressed by Us to James Douglas, Esquire, under Our Sign-Manual and Signet bearing date the Second day of September, One thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight: And further know you that We, reposing especial Trust and Confidence in the Prudence, Courage, and Loyalty of you the said Anthony Musgrave, of Our special Grace, certain Knowledge, and mere Motion, have thought fit to Constitute and Appoint, and do by these Presents Constitute and Appoint you to be during Our Will and Pleasure Our Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over Our Colony of British Columbia and its Dependencies, and in and over all Forts and Garrisons erected and established, or to be erected and established, in Our said Colony: And We do hereby Authorize and Command you to do and execute all things in due manner that shall belong to your said Command and the Trust We have reposed in you, according to the several Powers and Directions granted or appointed you by this
