Double, or Long Vowels.

Aa, no corresponding sound in English—being twice the length of the

letter a.

Ee, as ee in bee, seed.

Oo, as oo in woo, coo.

Uu, no corresponding sound in English—being a modulated vowel sound, between a in father, and a in all, or a prolongation of u in nun.
