The Governor in Council appoints the president of the CBC. The Corporation, on the recommendation of the president and with the approval of the Governor in Council, appoints the executive vice-president. The ranges of compensation into which the salaries for these two positions fall have been published under the terms of the Public Compensation Restraint Act. (Tabled November 17, 1983)

With regard to the salaries paid to other members of the CBC executive, while the salaries in question are in the \$75,000—\$100,000 range, it has not been customary to require the CBC to provide such details of its internal management and administration as the salaries of individual employees. The background to this custom was explained in detail in the reply to question No. 2,530 answered November 6, 1975.
