A statue of General Wolfe, the hero of Quebec is to be unveiled next June, in Greenwich Royal Park, London, England, by the Marquis de Montcalm.

The sculptor, Dr. Tait McKenzie,
has just completed a restudy of the working
model, three feet in height, which embedies
all the qualities of the large figure described
in the attached account. An edition limited to
ten or twelve copies will be issued to subscribers, at a cost of \$1,000 each. They will
be cast by the lost wax process, and each will
be retouched and signed by the artist.

These will be ready for distribution early next Spring.
