You will re-establish the credit of the Province of Canada, on that high footing which every man of probity within its limits is conscious that it merits, and you will rescue its peaceful moral inhabitants from the character for turbulence which their enemies have recently, and most foully, been labouring to affix upon them in the eyes of the whole world. All this you will assuredly accomplish by an upright, straightforward line of conduct, consonant alike to the dictates of sound loyalty and genuine patriotism, and inflexibly pursued, without fear of censure or hope of reward. And may the eternal principles of truth, honor and justice overrule your deliberations.
